

As a Forest School, we are committed to nature immersion, flow learning, and authentic play. We believe in intentionally slowing down to promote mindfulness, kindness, social connection, and self-empowerment. We aim to stimulate children's innate curiosity, foster compassion and empathy for the earth and all living beings, and allow space for emergent curriculum to unfold organically each day. Teachers' roles are as guides; actively modeling engagement in nature by using inquiry-based teaching strategies, making observations, and documenting learning.

Daily Schedule:

9-9:30- Drop off and prepare for nature play 9:30-10:30- Nature Play 10:30-11:00 Snack 11:00- 12:15 - Nature Play 12:15-1:00- Lunch 1:00-2:00 - Quiet time play 2:00-2:30 - Free play 2:30-3:00 - Pick-up

Bring DAILY according to the weather in a backpack/bag:

- Cold lunch
- Close-toed shoes are required
- Rubber boots
- Extra set of clothes
- Swimsuit
- Towel
- Brimmed hat
- Fleece Jacket
- Comfortable clothing
- Wool socks on cool/rain days
- Rain jacket and hat

DRESSING YOUR CHILD: Expect your child to come home dirty and wet. Children are encouraged to play and play can sometimes be messy. Please be aware of this when dressing your child. We will do our best to wear coveralls and rain suits when appropriate.

NATURE PLAY: includes activities such as hiking, pond study, gardening, guided nature study, painting, making a woodland band, building forts, and simply just playing in the mud or water.

FIELD TRIPS: As the water warms I would like to take the children to Grants Point or on "Field Trips" to places such as Capser Trail.

RAIN DAYS: We will meet at the property on Rough Road regardless of weather. Children will play outside on rain days, with the exception of thunder and lightning. If the weather is looking to be really poor an additional indoor option is my home on Old Fort Road. We'll bake cookies and make a fort and maybe watch a movie, you know splurge a little. ;)
